August is the eighth month of the year in the Gregorian Calendar and one of seven Gregorian months with a length of 31 days. This month was originally named Sestilis in Latin because it was the sixth month in the original ten month Roman calendar under Romulus in 753 BC, when March was the first month of the year.

About 700 BC it became the eighth month when Jan. & Feb. were added

to the year before March by King Numa Pompilius, who gave it 29 days. Julius Caesar added two days when he created the Julilan calendar in 45 BC giving it its modern length of 31 days. In 8 BC it was renamed in honor of Augusts, who did not take a day from February.

In common years, no other month starts on the same day of the week as August, though in leap years February starts on the same day.

Augusts' birthstone is the peridot or onyx. Its flower is the gladiolus or poppy meaning strength

of character, love, marriage and family.

On Aug. 6, 1945, Hiroshima was bombed and 3 days later so was Nagasaki in the only use of nuclear weapons against people. On Aug. 15, 1945, Emperor Hira hito declared Japan's unconditional surrender officially ending the 2nd WW.

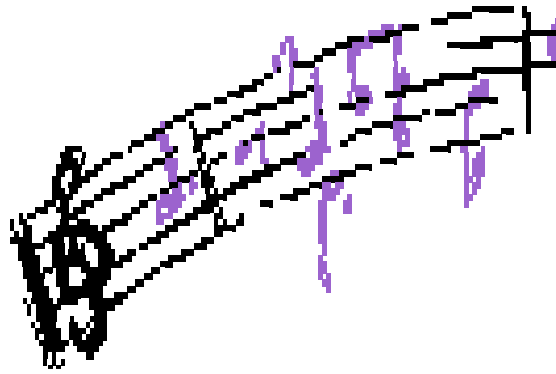

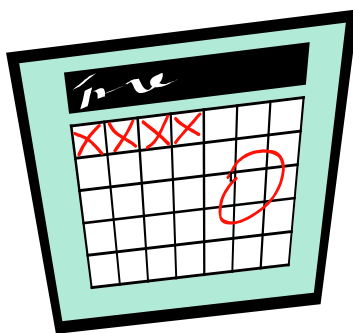
