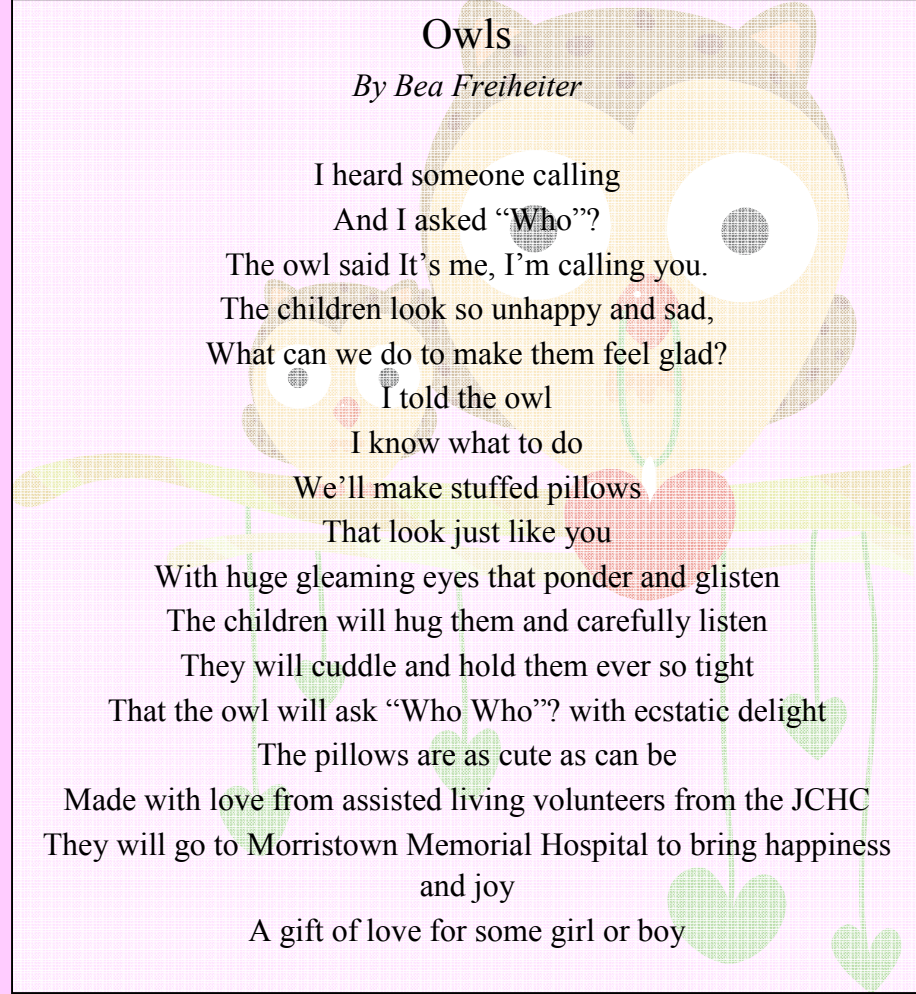


Owls

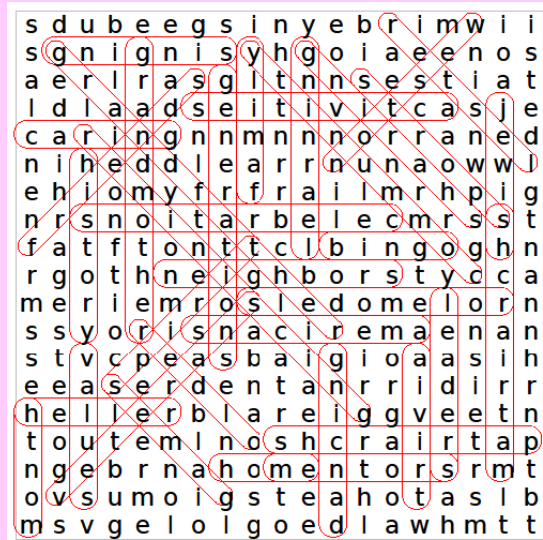

Administrator's Corner

June 2012

Warm weather is upon us and summer is just around the corner. The Lester maintenance team will be cleaning all apartment air conditioning filters to ensure that all units are running properly and efficiently. Now would be a good time to test the air conditioning unit in your apartment to make sure it is working properly. If you find that yours is not working as it should, please be sure to notify the Concierge so that it can be repaired in a timely manner.

This past month I included a flyer in your monthly handout packet with information regarding dining room safety. Please pay special attention to the recommendations made in that flyer and be sure to arrive at the dining room at the designated times to ensure continued safety of your fellow residents and the Lester staff.

The May 'Chat with CEO' for Heller residents had to be cancelled and is being rescheduled for Tuesday June 5th at 7PM. Mr. Harold Colton-Max, CEO of the JCHC, will be coming to Lester to meet with the Heller residents and will be asking for your feedback and recommendations. On the 17th we will be celebrating Father's Day with a special presentation in the morning and an entertainer in the evening. Also, on Sunday June 24th we will be having our sixth annual Western Day Bar-B-Q. If you missed this event in previous years, I highly encourage you to attend. We plan to have live music, entertainment, free t-shirts and fun for the entire family - please be sure to encourage your children, grandchildren and friends to join us as well!

As I noted this past month, we are in the process of making a number of improvements to our building and outdoor spaces.

Nine new benches have been installed outside the building along the walkways. Also, the common-area bathrooms on the first and second floors are undergoing a complete renovation and should be back in service by the end of this month. The theater will be getting a number of upgrades and the Heller Multi-Purpose Room will have theater equipment installed in it for presentations and activities. The Heller piano room furniture and the Weston living room and library furniture are also going to be replaced toward the end of the month and many new chairs have been purchased for our multi-purpose rooms. The computers in the computer lab will all be getting software updates (Windows 7) and the CogniFit program will now be web-based only. Lastly, toward the end of the month we plan to make Wi-Fi (wireless internet service) available for residents and guests in the first and second floor lobby areas. This service will be provided at no added cost and is being set up for your convenience and enjoyment. We will make every effort to minimize disruptions to the day-to-day operations while these renovations are underway and appreciate your continued patience while we work to update our building and improve our services to you.
