Dear Weston Residents, Families, Staff, & Contractors,

There is one resident and three employees that have tested positive for COVID-19. They are following quarantine protocols.

We have a number of residents that have had exposure from socializing during the holiday. We are grateful to the staff and residents that continue to take precautions in their personal life to assure the health and safety of residents, themselves, and their families.

Our employees and residents have been vaccinated according to CDC guidance. We continue to wear masks and goggles throughout the community. These precautions have safeguarded our residents from COVID-19 for over a year as evidenced by Weston not having a positive case in a year.

The state of New Jersey continues to see a dramatic increase in COVID-19 cases and hospitalizations following the holiday and with the arrival of cold weather driving people to gather indoors. All New Jersey counties are now considered to have a high rate of transmission per the State of New Jersey's CALI Score rating system.

As a result, we are continuing to follow the guidelines below:

- Masks are required for everyone: residents, staff, vendors, and visitors while in public areas throughout campus.
- Masks are required inside your apartment if an employee or vendor is present.
- Visitors must continue to wear masks and complete the screening process at the concierge desk.

We are re-instituting visitation by appointment only. Visits will be conducted as follows:

- If you are experiencing any symptoms, including flu and cold-like symptoms, please refrain from visiting.
- 30 minutes each, 1 visit per day per resident
- Limit of 2 visitors at one time
- Visits will be in designated areas not in apartments
- Visits will be scheduled by phone or email with Joan Wesolowski. Please do not expect a response from Joan unless the time requested is booked for another visit. She can be reached at (973)929-2727 or joanw@jchcorp.org
- Visits must be scheduled in advance of 24 hours by 4pm M-F. Weekend visits must also be scheduled by 4m on Friday.
- If visits are not scheduled as described above, you will be turned away at the security desk.
- If you are late for your visit, it will still end on time. This is necessary to accommodate visits for all residents and families.

The following services will be curtailed until further notice:

- Dining will be closed. Meals will be served in resident apartments
- Recreation will be modified, activities will be limited to in the hallways and in front of your respective apartment door. Ex: Hallway bingo, chair exercise, music...

- Hair salon will be closed
- Rehab will occur in the afternoon and may be in individual apartments on a case by case basis
- Although not recommended, vaccinated residents may continue to walk throughout the facility as long as they can adhere to the mask mandate. They are not restricted to their apartments.
